



Dear Parents,

**Skoolbo – Go! US Kids Go!** is a great new site to help children with reading and math. Children are immersed in an incredible learning world and become highly motivated by the inbuilt rewards mechanisms designed to encourage healthy use and to maximize learning.

Your child has been provided with an account that grants full usage of the program for free both at home and at school. As a parent you will also be able to view your child's results via the **Parent Dashboard** (see more details about this in the **Parent Guide!**) and, if you wish, you will be able to purchase additional reports in the future. These additional reports are optional—your child has full functionality of the program whether you choose to buy the reports or not. There is no advertising on *Skoolbo* and there are no in-app purchases. Children are not able to communicate on *Skoolbo*, thus ensuring no possibility of unsafe interactions.

### How to get going at home:

- *Skoolbo* is available for download on **computers** ([www.skoolbo.com/downloads](http://www.skoolbo.com/downloads)) and **tablets** (search for *Skoolbo Common Core* at the Apple App Store for iPad users or Google Play for Android users). *Skoolbo* can also be played on the Internet browser ([dashboard.skoolbo.com](http://dashboard.skoolbo.com)) but this is not recommended.
- Open the software and select **PARENTS**.
- Your child's username is \_\_\_\_\_. **It should be the first 8 letters of your child's first name followed by 4 randomly generated numerical digits, e.g. jennifer1234.** The password (always a color and an animal) is by default the color BLACK and the animal BEE, though your child may have changed this at school.

### Tips for Maximum Benefit

- Encourage your child to use *Skoolbo* four to five times per week for around 20-30 minutes each time (each time should be about ten games, after which your child is rewarded a **Lucky Prize**).
- Do not let other children (or adults) play on your child's account. *Skoolbo* uses a smart algorithm that determines the most appropriate learning activities specifically for your child based on his or her recent performance. Other users could affect the level of activity presented to your child.
- Celebrate your child's successes. Examples include the 1,000th Correct Answer milestone and other improvement awards.
